Summary of 2011/2012 School Calendar

Minimum number of Instructional Days	186 days
Non-Instructional Days <i>(incl. 1.25 Inservice)</i>	5
District In-service Day	1
Administrative Day	1
Total Days in Session	193 days

Note: 0.25 of the in-district Pro-D days will be used for Inservice activities.

Days of instruction are different than "days in session". Days in session are days that school is "open" but the students are not necessarily in attendance. On a "day of instruction", students are to be in attendance and under supervision for the purposes of receiving instruction in an educational program.

Minimum Number of Instructional Hours

In a school year, a Board of Education must offer not less than the hours of instruction multiplied by the minimum number of days of instruction as set out in the standard school calendar for the school year, as follows:

Gr. K*-7: 4.75 hrs x min. number of days of instruction
[* full day K is offered at all SD85 elem. schools 2011/12]
Gr. 8-12: 5.15 hrs x min. number of days of instruction
